Dear Rep. Norwood:

On behalf of the Health Policy Committee of the Mental Health Liaison Group (MHLG) -- a coalition composed of provider, family and consumer organizations -- we are writing to express our strong support for the "Patient Access to Responsible Care Act of 1997" (H.R. 1415).

This measure provides essential protections for consumers in the private health insurance marketplace. MHLG is particularly pleased that the legislation contains provisions ensuring continuity of care for people with special health care needs and chronic conditions. Among other things, H.R. 1415 assures timely appeals, reforms the utilization review process to require the use of properly trained personnel and guarantees access to emergency and urgent care services (which is of specific concern to adults with severe mental illnesses and children with serious emotional disturbances).

Given the history of insurance discrimination against people with mental disorders and the serious problems associated with the delivery of mental health care by HMOs, the "Patient Access to Responsible Care Act" represents a critical step forward.

You have our full support.
